We are pleased to announce that Unk's Place has been deemed as QRTP Compliant with the Ohio Department of Job & Family Services (ODJFS)!

We understand that with this designation that we have the opportunity to provide services in a least restrictive setting that will not only provide services for the young men that we serve, but now we have an opportunity to help serve the families of the youth that are placed with us for a limited amount of time.

Being QRTP Compliant means that we:

- ♦ Are a licensed and nationally accredited
- ♦ Have adopted a trauma—informed treatment model
- ♦ Have a registered or licensed nurse and other licensed clinical staff available 24/7
- ♦ Have a staff who are trauma-informed trained
- Facilitate family outreach and participation in the youth's treatment program
- Provide discharge planning and aftercare support for at least six month post discharge.

We look forward to working with the caseworkers and other service providers to help meet the social, emotional and mental health needs of our youth and families.
